

Proposed Rules of Engagement for the
2010 Safe Yield Task Force
(SYTF 2010)

Upon review of ADWR's Assessment of the Tucson Active Management Area, the TAMA Groundwater Users Advisory Council (GUAC) wishes to reconstitute the Safe Yield Task Force (SYTF) to develop recommendations for how our AMA can achieve safe-yield by 2025.

Those who agree to serve on the SYTF 2010 will be a representative sample of water interests throughout our AMA and will be invited by the GUAC.

Our charge is:

Develop alternatives across all sectors to achieve and maintain Safe Yield by 2025 and submit those alternatives to the GUAC for further implementation actions.

The recommendations that came out of the original SYTF in 2000 will form the jumping off point for the work of the SYTF 2010.

SYTF 2010 will revisit, prioritize, and update the 2000 SYTF issues into feasible solutions that will form our basis for action in 2011.

SYTF 2010 members will be committed to actively engage and be willing to serve for 6 to 9 months, attend one meeting a month (possibly two when needed), and to communicate via email between meetings.

The Task Force will develop recommendations based upon consensus.

SYTF 2010 meetings are not closed, and comments and suggestions are welcome.

SYTF 2010 will submit all consensus solutions and action recommendations to the GUAC in Spring 2011.
